

HOW TO CARE FOR YOUR FURNITURE

At SCF our furniture is manufactured to the highest standard and to help maintain its quality we provide the following guidelines:

Maintenance

The life of your furniture may be shortened if you do not undertake regular maintenance or safeguard against improper use, such as:

Placing furniture manufactured from solid timber too close to radiators or other sources of heat may cause the timber to split or the lacquer to craze.

Wooden chairs are best suited to carpeted areas, rather than wooden or stone flooring. Chair leg glides can be fitted to give added protection for floors.

Tables, chairs and stools should be checked at least every six months and nuts tightened on the table joints.

✓ To clean we suggest using a warm, damp and slightly soapy cloth to wipe over surfaces.
